Thank you very much for your precious prayers and offerings. A mission team comprised of 10 members including 4 from the Kyushu Region was sent to Cambodia from December 28 through 31 to pursue the work of The Cornerstone Orphanage Cambodia and to give spiritual covering to the online church members there.

The Cornerstone Orphanage Cambodia, like The Water Flowing from the Sanctuary Mission, was established with The Lord’s Cross Christian Center Tokyo Antioch Church as its parent organization. It is now an International NGO and supports each child to become independent in the future. The children are under the spiritual covering of the parent organization as online church members.

Meetings were held two evenings in a row. In the live webcast of the meetings, people throughout the world saw the children showing significant spiritual growth and praising God with vivid smiles on their faces as well as the baptismal ceremony of 4 children and 1 staff member.

In the daytime, throwing a curry party, playing in an amusement park and going bowling were planned to enjoy fellowship with the children. At the amusement park, God blessed the team in that, not only the admission tickets for the four younger children were free of charge, but all the rides became free of charge for all those who went. The first bowling game in a big shopping mall was a memorable time in which the children cheered at every strike and gutter ball alike. They all looked nervous in their first visit to a shopping mall. They had never ridden an escalator, but looked enjoying the ride although looking a little awkward.

The main vocalist of a well-known Japanese music group offered special presents to each of the children. They yelped with delight with such a surprise. The team accomplished all the mission thanks to the Lord’s blessings, perfect protection and your prayers.

Team to Cambodia

Thank you for your intercessory prayer with fasting.

Cambodia team was sent from 28th December to the 31st. I was able to go there and come back safely. This was the 3rd dispatch team after Cambodia orphanage had become an online member of Tokyo Antioch church and the staff, Miss Katsuko Maeda was anointed as an assistant pastor. Prophecies spoken during the prayer meeting before Cambodia dispatch were that Cambodia orphanage will be strengthened as a body of a church by the team being sent, as it is being growing as an online church by God during this short dispatch, that we can see growth of orphan children, who are church members, and that in future, some of the children are led to be orphanage staffs, pastors and evangelists. So I expected a lot and we had prepared prayer so that we could carry out His will.

The team arrived at Phnom Penh on the 28th and had a Japanese curry party on the following day. Japanese curry seemed to be their gorgeous meal that they could eat few times a year. So we served it plus Kentucky fried chicken and juice, which are usually served at special times. Orphanage staffs and all the team members had this meal together. We had a very en-



joyable time, seeing children's contented face.

On the 30th, we went to an amusement park in the morning and bowling alley in the afternoon. At the amusement park, at the beginning, they said we had to pay the entrance fees and rides separately, and Japanese had to pay expensive fees for foreigners. So we were afraid that we would have some shortage of money, because our budget was collection of registration fees of each team members. However, when our local staffs negotiated with the amusement park, 4 small kids' entrance fees and rides fees were made free of charge, and Japanese team members were able to enter with local entrance fees at first. However, later, they made all the rides fees free of charge! That means that we paid only local entrance fees for all of us including Japanese members, beside 4 small kids. That was how the Lord's blessing was shown.

After that, we headed for Eon, a Japanese shopping mall, which was built recently and went to the bowling alley in it. I heard that it was first time for children to enter Eon, and to play bowling. They were so cutely nervous before entering Eon. The child who took escalator for the first time was held tightly from both sides, watching the moving staircases curiously. When they played bowling for the first time, they watched how people of other lanes

were playing and enjoyed to throw the bowling balls. None of them sat and they were standing where the bowlers were supposed to be, excited of any small happenings.

Among all the low score members, how could I, who used to play quite well before scored only 28 points, which is lower than some of the small children's scores? I didn't purposely try to play badly. Next time, I need to beat them.

The holy meetings of two nights were broadcasted to the world online. Water baptism was held for 4 children and one of staffs as planned for this time. We were blessed by very deep presence of God, which was shown during the water baptism. One of the water-baptized children said during her testimony, "At first, I wanted to get water-baptized in Israel, but I was spoken by God, when I was reading Bible, 'Do not rely on your own understanding'. In this way, God spoke to me that being water-baptized in Cambodia is the best for me." As it was spoken by God before this dispatch, I could witness children's growth in faith. Also God spoke to me from this.

The Lord also spoke to us to send videos of children, singing praise songs in Japanese language to the main vocalist of a famous music group, who has been supporting the Cornerstone orphanage and who gave nice presents to the children this time. So we could shoot video



of all of the orphanage children praising as a group in the holy meeting. It was clear that the Lord was present during children's praising even during the rehearsal. Someone who was watching online holy meeting informed us that the Lord's presence in children's praising blessed the person. Their praising was improving with better Japanese language pronunciation.

In the message of holy meeting, God spoke from verse 1-2 of Genesis chapter 12 that if one relies on God, he will receive the best life through Pastor Paul Akimoto. Children were given homework and encouraged to pray. Also, it was encouraged to listen to God for a vision and step out from there.

It was a wonderfully blessed dispatch, even though it was a short period. I give thanks to the Lord. Thank you for your intercessory prayer.

I have joined in the Cambodia team and visited the Cornerstone Orphanage Cambodia from 28th December to the 31st. We had water baptism for 5 people this time.

They are 3 University male students, one female high school student and one of local staffs. When I heard the testimony of each of them, I knew that they experienced God and give thanks to God.

The local staff, who had water baptism this time came to work at this orphanage several years ago, was saved at the time of Cambodia team in 2015, and was water baptized this time.

Cambodia orphanage has become online member of Tokyo Antioch church on January 2015. I felt church blessing is poured onto them and gave thanks to God from my heart.

Children in Cambodia orphanage like praising very much. I was touched to hear them praising many praise songs in Japanese and sing to God from their heart.

We held a curry party in the afternoon on the 29th. They had curry rice with a lot of meat, together with Kentucky fried chicken and tin juice. I was impressed by the way they were eating contently, saying, "I had enough!", and "Nice!"

On the 30th, we went to an amusement park

and a bowling alley to have a time to enjoy with the children. It was like we had reserved the amusement park, because we went there early in the morning and there were not many other people. Also, after we went on 7 rides, the fees were made all free of charge! Children's nice smiles were impressive to me.

We went to a bowling alley in the afternoon. It was the first experience for most of the children, but I was surprised by their good skill. Small children were quite good. One of the girls threw with only right hand, because her left hand does not move. However, she got two strikes! She won applause and was very happy. They took ice cream twice, which they cannot usually eat. I was so happy because I could see their shining smile.

These children came to this orphanage be-



cause of their very hard situation. Some of them could have died if they didn't come to this orphanage. They could not smile at the beginning because their hurt in their heart was too deep. This time, I tried to talk to a boy, whose smile I have never seen before. Then, he answered me with a shy smile. This boy smiled! When I saw him smiled, I was about to shed tears. I felt the importance to go over there to see, talk and mix with them, as well as to pray intercessory prayer for them.

I give thanks to God that I could see wonderful shining smiles of children a lot. And thank you for your prayer.
